THE CITY OF DIXON
DIXON WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY
SOLANO COUNTY**

The City of Dixon owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility that treats domestic and commercial wastewater in Dixon, Solano County. The Discharger's wastewater system is regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. 94-187 and Cease and Desist (C&D) Order No. 97-193. The Discharger has violated the WDRs and C&D Order by causing groundwater pollution and failing to construct facility improvements to minimize and control the groundwater pollution. The Regional Board will consider whether to adopt a Cease and Desist Order for the Discharger.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **20 June 2005**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **20 June 2005**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **20 June 2005** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
