POST-CLOSURE MAINTENANCE OF RED HILL LANDFILL FACILITY

CLASS III LANDFILL AND CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS

CALAVERAS COUNTY

The County of Calaveras owns and the County of Calaveras Department of Public Works operates the Red Hill Landfill, which is located two miles east of Angels Camp in Calaveras County. The Facility was designed and operated as a Class III landfill. The Facility began accepting waste in mid-1975 and ceased acceptance in October 1990. Waste disposal operations were limited to 17-acres, consisting of three separate landfill units and two lined Class II surface impoundments. The revised Waste Discharge Requirements contain post-closure maintenance requirements for the closed landfill.

A **formal** public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Board meeting which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **30 March 2006**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit such comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **30 March 2006**. All written comments received after **30 March 2006** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record in doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
