(National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. CA0079391)
for

CITY OF JACKSON
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
AMADOR COUNTY

The City of Jackson (hereinafter Discharger) is the owner and operator of the Jackson Wastewater Treatment Plant (hereinafter Facility), a publicly owned treatment works (POTW) in Jackson, Amador County. The Facility discharges tertiary treated wastewater to Jackson Creek, a tributary to the Mokelumne River within the Delta, via Dry Creek. The tentative NPDES permit is the proposed renewal of existing Order No. 5-00-173 which currently regulates the subject discharge. The tentative NPDES permit renewal proposes new effluent limitations and establishes a time schedule for the Discharger to discharge only under 20-to-1 receiving water for all discharges to Jackson Creek. Also enclosed with the tentative permit is a proposed alternative option of year-round discharge under any dilution conditions.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **15 October 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative NPDES permit was issued on **31 August 2007**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item, including the proposed alternative option, shall

submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than by noon on **1 October 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon on **1 October 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
