NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR
COUNTY OF YOLO
PLANNING AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT
YOLO COUNTY CENTRAL LANDFILL
CLASS III LANDFILLS & CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS
CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, CLOSURE, POST-CLOSURE MAINTENANCE
AND CORRECTIVE ACTION
YOLO COUNTY

The County of Yolo Planning and Public Works Department owns and operates the Yolo County Central Landfill. The waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the landfill are being revised to approve operation of bioreactors at the landfill under Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 258.4 - Research, Development, and Demonstration Permits once California becomes an approved state under this rule. The proposed WDRs would also approve an increase in the final height of future landfill modules by 60 feet as previously approved by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors in approving a Final Environmental Impact Report. The proposed WDRs also provide requirements for the proposed mining of bioreactor units to recover recyclables. Details about these proposals and the proposed requirements are provided in the tentative WDRs.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **5 November 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **5 November 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5 November 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
