FOR OPERATION OF HOLIDAY HARBOR MARINA
SHASTA COUNTY

Holiday Harbor Incorporated owns and operates Holiday Harbor Marina on Shasta Lake in accordance with a special use permit issued by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service, who administers the property for the public. These Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) are being revised to rescind WDR Order No. 93-132, prescribe operational requirements for a new wastewater treatment and disposal system, and revise the monitoring requirements to include septic tank effluent and groundwater sampling and reporting.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **23 June 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The revised Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements was issued on **20 May 2008**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than by noon on **23 June 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon on **23 June 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
