**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
FOR  
STANISLAUS COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES  
FOR  
OPERATION OF  
FINK ROAD CLASS II AND CLASS III LANDFILLS  
CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS  
STANISLAUS COUNTY

The Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources owns and operates an active Class III municipal solid waste landfill, Class II surface impoundments, and a Class II ash monofill at the Fink Road Landfill located near Crows Landing. The County requested a revision of the waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the facility to approve the discharge of treated wood waste at the composite-lined Cell 4 of landfill LF-2, and future cells of LF-2 as allowed by AB 1353 under the Health and Safety Code. The proposed Order also requires evaluation and corrective action for a potential release from landfill LF-3. The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **2 May 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **2 May 2008**.

Written evidence or comments submitted after **2 May 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
