The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board) Executive Office will consider approval of a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulation for Entry of Administrative Civil Liability Order, No. R1-2016-0049 (proposed Order) that proposes a settlement with the Fort Bragg Municipal Improvement District No. 1 (Discharger) to resolve violations subject to mandatory minimum penalties (MMPs) alleged in Order No. R1-2016-0030. The Order proposes that the Regional Water Board assess mandatory minimum penalties in the amount of \$39,000 for violations of effluent limits, and further proposes that the Discharger will apply the penalties towards two Compliance Projects.
