ORDER NO. 72-18

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 69-34

KAWNEER COMPANY, RICHMOND PLANT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

1. On June 24, 1969 this Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 69-34 prescribing requirements as to the nature of two waste discharges by Kawneer Company from a manufacturing plant in Richmond with one discharge being directed into two diked ponds and the other being emptied into a ditch which conveyed the waste 3500 feet northwest into San Pablo Bay.
2. Information received from Kawneer Company indicates that the Richmond Plant operation has been discontinued and that the plant has been vacated. The waste material in the two company ponds has been removed and the pond area has been restored to its former natural ground condition.
3. Inspection by the Board's staff has confirmed this information.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Board's Resolution No. 69-34 is rescinded.
