ORDER NO. 86-98

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR:

THE CITY OF HALF MOON BAY AND
DEANE & DEANE, INC.


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (hereinafter Board) finds that:

1. Water Code Section 13263(e) and the State Board's regulations (Title 23, CAC, Section 2232.2) require the Board to review waste discharge requirements periodically and determine if the requirements are adequate or necessary.
2. The City of Half Moon Bay and Deane & Deane, Inc. (hereinafter dischargers) filed a Report of Waste Discharge for a proposed partial water reclamation project on July 20, 1972.
3. The dischargers proposed to transport secondary effluent from secondary treatment facilities to be constructed by the City of Half Moon Bay to a landscape impoundment. The wastewater would be pumped to sprinklers for turf irrigation of a golf course. The impoundment and golf course were within the property of Deane & Deane, Inc., located about three miles from the City's treatment plant.
4. On October 26, 1972, the Board adopted Order No. 72-96, prescribing discharge requirements covering the use of secondary effluent for landscape irrigation of a golf course by the City of Half Moon Bay and Deane & Deane, Inc.
5. In September 1983, the City of Half Moon Bay's wastewater treatment plant ceased discharging and all flow was diverted to the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside's regional treatment plant. Since September 1983, the dischargers have not used reclaimed wastewater for irrigation of the golf course. Plans to use reclaimed wastewater in the future will involve different treatment and use facilities than described in Order No. 72-96.
6. This Order will rescind the requirements which permit the discharger to reclaim wastewater. Adoption of this Order is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100) of Division 13 of the Public Resources Code (CEQA) pursuant to Section 13389 of the California Water Code.

7. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of the waste discharge requirements.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: This Board's Order No. 72-96 is rescinded.
