I (we) understand that I (we) am (are) responsible for removing or modifying diversion works and impoundments, if applicable, to ensure that water subject to this revocation request is no longer diverted. Unauthorized diversion and use of water is considered a trespass and subject to enforcement action under Water Code section 1052 and 1831. It is my (our) responsibility to consult with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the Regional Water Quality Control Board and, if a jurisdictional size dam will be removed or breached, the Department of Water Resources, Division of Safety of Dams to ensure that removal of project facilities, if necessary, does not adversely affect a fishery or result in unregulated sediment discharge to a waterway.
