Amount:	4 cubic feet per second by direct diversion and 150 acre-feet per annum by storage
Season:	Direct Diversion: January 1 through December 31 of each year Storage: December 1 of each year to about May 30 of the succeeding year
Purpose of Use:	Municipal, Irrigation, and Stockwatering
Place of Use:	Within Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15, T6N, R13E, MDB&M, and Sections 33, 34, 35, and 36, T7N, R13E, MDB&M.
