HEARING OF OCTOBER 4, 1938
TRUCKEE RIVER APPLICATIONS

Dear Mr. Bryan:

In the above matter Mr. Spencer of the Bureau of Reclamation and I for the Truckee-Carson Irr'n District were assigned on same and saw you last May. To bring matter to date could you please advise me:-

1. Re Applications 5169 and 6534 of Conservation District which are to cover storage in the now being constructed Boca Reservoir, said reservoir being planned to hold somewhere between 40 000 A. F. at Elev. 4304 and 44 000 A. F. at El. 4807.7.

In May last we found the Applications modified to an assumed basis of 50 000 A. F. of contemplated storage together with a replenishment right for 10 000 A. F., or for a total of 60 000 A. F.

Could you please advise me of any modification or corrections made since May necessary to bring our copies then obtained up to date? ⁽¹⁾ none

2. Re Application 5170 for Power at Boca by water from both Truckee and Little Truckee, which latter would be from Boca Reservoir.

Has this filing been perfected with detail map called for with evident intention of being carried through? If so might I be furnished with copy of map and amendments of filing, and charges billed our District but sent to me? ⁽²⁾

3. Re applications 9247 & 9267 for 17 500 A. F. of applied for storage in Independence Lake for Municipal and Power purposes respectively.

Last May the filings were not clear as to any doubling of the single storage of 17 500 set up and change was contemplated. Also the plans failed to disclose the actual amount of raising of lake above the spillway or above a specific height of flashboards in spillway.

Could you please advise me of modifications or corrections for purpose of bringing the copies of last May up to date? If new map filed might I have copy of same, with billing for same as noted above? ⁽³⁾ no change
